## THE NEW ENERGY LABEL IS RELEVANT FOR YOU!

The energy label is a tool that allows suppliers to communicate the performance of their products to consumers. The new label will stimulate suppliers to develop ever more efficient products promoting research and investments in innovation.

### SUPPLIERS' SHOULD:

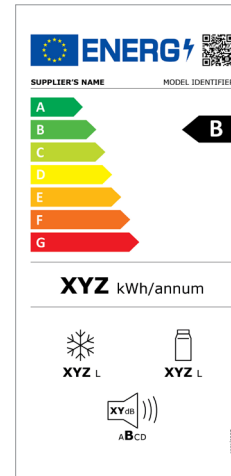
ensure that, according to the timing defined by the regulation, products placed on the market are accompanied with:

- printed labels;
- product information sheets made available through EPREL and in printed form upon retailers' request;

## WHAT IS NEW FOR SUPPLIERS

**New label:** here an example of the rescaled energy label for household refrigerators.

**New testing methods:** compliance with the new energy label regulation must be verified through appropriate physical testing in laboratories, that may differ from the ones performed to generate the old energy label.



**New registration:** since 1st January 2019, suppliers are obliged to register their equipment on the European Database for Energy Labelling (EPREL) before putting them on the European market. However, a new registration is required for those products for which the energy label is rescaled.

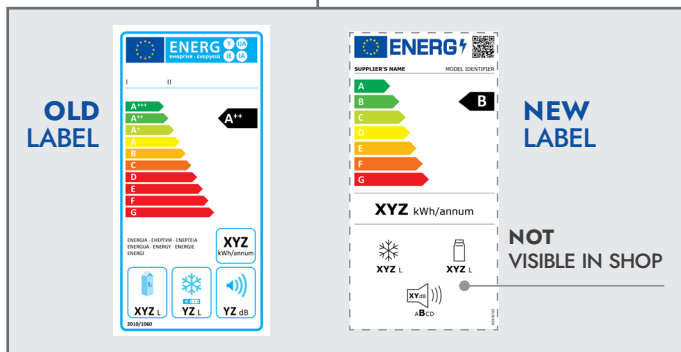
**New Eco-design rules:** in parallel with the rescaled energy label, also a new eco-design regulation is entering into force. The regulation introduces new requirements about energy efficiency, functionality, resource efficiency (e.g. availability of spare parts, after sales services to be provided to the consumers...) and information availability.

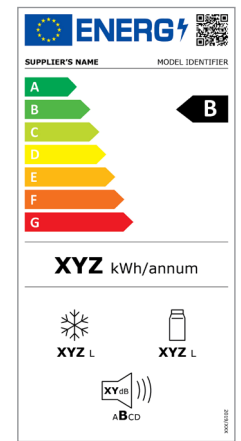
NEW ENERGY LABEL VISIBLE TO CONSUMERS ONLINE AND IN PHYSICAL STORES



To allow to sell the products in retailer's stock that still have the old label. This applies to discontinued products or in case of supplier's cessation of activities.
